

Memorandum of Understanding for Academic Cooperation
between
RUHR UNIVERSITY BOCHUM, GERMANY
and
UNIVERSITY OF DELHI

Preamble

The **Center for Religious Studies** at Ruhr University Bochum, Germany (CERES), and the **Department of History** at the University of Delhi, India, seek to expand scholarly ties, facilitate academic cooperation, increase educational opportunities, enrich the educational and research environment and promote international and inter-cultural understanding. Through this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), both CERES and the Department of History at the University of Delhi agree to explore educational and scientific cooperation efforts between the two institutions.

This MoU establishes guidelines for possible collaboration between the parties but is not intended to create any specific commitment or obligation of either party to the other. The specific terms and conditions of each collaboration program will be determined in a separate agreement which will form an appendix to this MoU.

Possible areas of collaboration may include, but will not be limited to, the activities detailed below:

1. Short-term targets: Shared research on the history of medieval and early modern Jain manuscript culture.
2. Mid-term targets: Development of future research collaborations.
3. Coordination of the Collaboration

Each institution shall designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate the specific agreement upon activities, under this MoU.

4. Use of names

Except in promoting the activities proposed in Article 1 and 2 above among its faculty and students, neither party may use the name of the other party in any form of advertising or publicity without a prior express written permission of the other party.

5. Term, termination, and amendment

This MoU for cooperation becomes effective on the date of execution and will remain in effect for three (3) years from the date hereof, unless terminated by either party, for any reason, by a written notice given three months in advance. The MoU may be amended by a written instrument signed by both parties.
