CONQUEST

Conquest, organized by the Consulting Club at FMS during Fiesta, is a case competition registered on the Unstop platform. Open to both undergraduate and postgraduate students, the 2022 edition (Date: 25th February 2022) of Conquest garnered significant traction with over 56.5k impressions and the active participation of more than 900 teams. This event provides a platform for students to showcase their analytical and problem-solving skills, attracting a diverse and engaged audience.

Every round serves as an elimination stage, and specific details for each round are outlined below:

1.Quiz:

The quiz is scheduled to take place on the Unstop platform, comprising approximately 25-30 questions. Following the completion of the quiz, the top 25 teams with the highest scores are selected to advance to the next round.

2.Case Study:

20 leading teams receive a case study, and their solutions for the assigned case are solicited. Subsequently, based on the submitted solutions, the top 6 teams are selected to progress to the next round.

3.Case Presentation:

The top six participants are required to present their case problems to the jury, followed by a round of questioning. The announcement of the three winners concludes this phase.
