Indian Women's Movement: Methodological Aspects

This is planned as a set of four lectures, focusing on the women's movement in India, seen through the lens of contemporary development processes and challenges to social change in recent times. Given the vast span and time frame of struggles for change, the focus will not be on a direct narration of events. Rather, the lectures will provide an occasion to focus on methodological aspects through readings around a selection of documents covering almost a hundred years of activism around women's rights.

The Objective is to introduce the participants to different perspectives, the intense debates and the diverse approaches that emerged.

Outcome:

It is hoped that the discussions shall open up the need to understand the theme of Rights through these to trace the broad contours of the evolution of ideas pick up some of the persistent themes that emerged from colonial times to the present to trace continuities as well as the divergences, while contextualizing these in the backdrop of development goals and the objectives identified at the time of the freedom struggle, the framing of the Constitution and after, alongside issues arising from other contexts, including the international discourse on women's rights.

The series of four lectures would be on following subthemes:

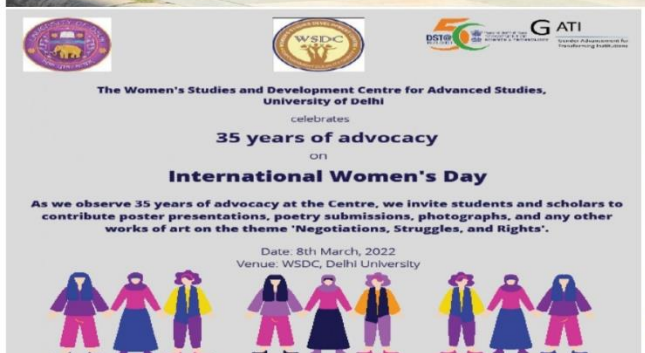
1. Confronting Colonialism: Women Speak of Rights in Pre-independence India

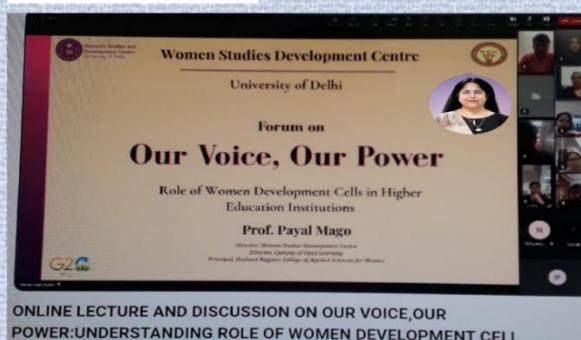
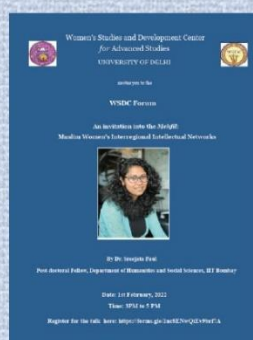
