2. The Department organized 10 major student events: HR Conclave, A Day with Alum, The Annual Convention, Imprints, Reminiscence, Genesis, Moolyankan, Vishleshan, Markquest, and Arthiniti. In terms of achievements we were ranked at the 26th Best B-School to study with by Outlook, 2020. For Placements we have had 91% student placement with 32 companies visiting the campus. The highest package was 21.5 LPA and the average went upto 11.97 LPA. In terms of summer internships, the maximum stipend offered was 2 Lakhs (for 2 months). Of the companies visiting the campus, 36.53% of the companies feature in the Forbes 500 Companies list.
