THEME: ANDERSON'S NATIONALIST IS A CONSUMER?

- Anderson contends with rise of "Print Capitalism", addressing "national" communities.
- These texts resorted to vernacular languages rather than privileged languages, which made up the new nation and who had previously been unschooled in privileged languages.
- The religious imaginary community had been characterized by a conception of temporality in which cosmology and history were "indistinguishable", so that the material world were always religious truths.
- Throughout the new imagined communities, however, mutually disconnected individuals were aware that they were mutually connected in the life of their nation- "calendrically through homogeneous time".
