Fellowship support for stay in Germany @ 3000 euros per year would be provided by the Max-Planck Society. The international travel cost including visa fee and overseas medical insurance will be provided by Indo-German Science & Technology Centre (IGSTC) as the implementing agency on behalf of the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India.
