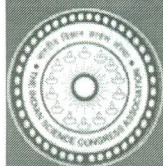

In continuation of our sanction order of even number dated 03-05-2007 and subsequent orders to the above mentioned fellowship, SERB hereby accords sanction to the additional amount of Rs.68,00,000/- (Rupees Sixty-eight Lakh only) towards revision of fellowship amount (because of further extension of the Fellowship for 5 years duration, with upper age limit of 68 years with fellowship of Rs.25,000/- per month, Research Grant of Rs.10.00 lakh per annum and Overhead Charges of Rs.60,000/- per annum) to the J.C Bose Fellow thus revising the total cost from Rs.53,10,000/- (Rupees Fifty-three lakh ten thousand only) to Rs.1,21,10,000/- (Rupees One Crore twenty-one lakh ten thousand only) for implementation of the above fellowship.

2. Other terms and conditions of the grant will remain unchanged for the fellowship.

4. This sanction is issued with the approval of competent authority under delegated powers and vide dairy no. 105 dated 05-01-2012.

In continuation of SERB/DST's Sanction Order Number "SR/S2/JCB-28/2011 dated 11/28/2011" and subsequent orders to the above mentioned fellowship, SERB hereby accords sanction to the additional amount of Rs.68,00,000/- (Rupees Sixty-eight Lakh only) towards revision of fellowship amount (because of further extension of the Fellowship for 5 years duration, with upper age limit of 68 years or till having a position in the Institute for research activity, with fellowship of Rs.25,000/- per month, Research Grant of Rs.10.00 lakh per annum and Overhead Charges of Rs.60,000/- per annum) to the J.C Bose Fellow thus revising the total cost from Rs.68,00,000/- (Rupees Sixty eight lakh only) to Rs.1,36,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore thirty six lakh only) for implementation of the above fellowship.
