



I extend a very warm welcome to all invited speakers, senior scientist, medal awardees, chair persons of different sessions and participants for their gracious presence in 38th All India Botanical Conference at University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

- 1. The Indian Botanical Society was founded on Dec 6, 1920 at a meeting held during the session of Indian Science Congress at Nagpur with nearly 25 members under the presidentship of late Dr. Winfield Dudgeon of the Ewing Christian College, Allahabad. Since then the Society is growing and now it has nearly 2500 life members and 300 annual members.
- 2. The society used to have its annual session with the Indian Science Congress Association meeting but since 1978 the society is holding its annual conference independently. The credit for this goes to late Prof. Y.S. Murty who shaped and nurtured the modern botanical society.
- 3. The society awards various medals every year
 - A. The Life Time Achievement Award: Instituted from 2009 by family members of Prof. V. Puri to be given to a distinguished Botanist who have rendered exceptional services to any branch of plant sciences and services to the society. This year the medal is being awarded to Prof. Dalbir Singh, (Retd. Prof. & Head, Department of Botany, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur), 12, Somerset Court S.W. Canada.
 - B. **Prof. Birbal Sahni Medal**: Instituted by Prof. T.S. Sadasivan in 1956 is awarded every year to a distinguished Indian Botanist for his devotion to the cause of Indian Botany. This year this medal is being awarded to Prof. P.C. Trivedi, (Former Vice Chancellor, DDU Gorakhpur University & RML Avadh University, Faizabad), 140-A, Vasundhara Colony, Tonk Road, Jaipur.
 - C. **Prof. Panchanan Maheshwari Medal:** Instituted by Dr. K. Subramanuyam in 1977. This medal is awarded to a distinguished botanist for original and significant contribution to the advancement of Botanical knowledge. This year it is being awarded to Prof. Arun Kumar Pandey, Department of Botany, University of Delhi, Delhi.
 - D. **Prof. Vishwambhar Puri Medal:** Instituted by his students in 1977 is awarded to a botanist for his significant contribution to the advancement of Botany. This year the receipient of this medal is Prof. N.C. Gautam, Vice Chancellor, Mahatma Gandhi Chitrakoot Gramodaya Vishwavidyalaya, Chitrakoot, Dist. Satna-485 334 (M.P.).
 - E. **Prof. Y.S. Murty Medal**: Instituted by his students and well wishes in 1985 is awarded to a Young Botanist of the society, below the age of 40 yrs, for his contribution to any branch of Botany. This year the recipient is Dr. Pankaj Kumar Arora, Research Professor, School of Biotechnology, Yeungnam University, South Korea.
- 4. To encourage Young & Budding Botanist we have started "Young Botanist Award" for the life members below the age of 35 yrs. The award include Dr. M.S. Swaminathan Merit Certificate and Dr. Bahadur Single Gold Medal for the best paper presented under "Young Botanist
