Dear Sir,

This is to inform you that a part of the first instalment of DST-PURSE Phase-II has been released by DST under the PURSE scheme to the University. According to the letter received from DST, the entire PURSE grant has been distributed in five instalments. The break up of the total cost is as Capital Assets (non-recurring head) for four years and Grants-in-aid General (recurring head) for five years.

Your Department has already been informed of the total amount allocated from the DST-PURSE Phase-II, as approved by the Vice Chancellor. In accordance with the same, the distribution and equipment requirement were received by our office from your side.

From the available funds in the first instalment, considering the requirement submitted by your Department, it has been sanctioned a total amount of Rupees sixty three lakhs seventy thousand only (Rs. 63.70 lakhs) out of the first instalment. Out of this, Rupees zero has been allocated under the non-recurring head (Capital Asset) for equipment purchase and Rupees sixty three lakhs seventy thousand only (Rs. 63.70 lakhs) has been allocated under the recurring head (Grants-in-aid General) for all the other requirments including consumables, manpower, domestic travel, contingency etc.

It is reiterated that the entire amount sanctioned to your Department falls in two subheads-Flexible component (85% of total which includes equipment and consumables) and Fixed component (15% of total out of which 10% is manpower, 1% is domestic travel and 4% is contingencies/maintenance/conferences/workshops).

2. 
3. <u>The Department/ Institute will appropriately limit the expenditure within the sanctioned amount in case</u> of any expected excess expenditure. The Department is requested to utilize the released funds in first one year.

4. The Department shall implement the aforesaid project at the Department of Zoology, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007 on FIST Program with the 'Terms and Conditions' already agreed to by the University. Further, as per Rule 211 of revised GFRs the accounts of this Project Grants at Grantee Organization shall be made available for inspection by the sanctioning authority/ audit where ever the Organization is called upon to do so.


5. There is no pending SE/UC on this Project as per details in the PFMS also. This is the first release of this project under FIST Program, which has been initiated, in this financial year so no previous UC is attached with this sanction order.

6. The University/ Institute will furnish to the DST, Utilization Certificate and an audited Statement of Expenditure pertaining to the grant immediately after the end of each financial year

7. The grant is being released subject to the 'Terms & Conditions' of the Program being agreed to by the Department of Zoology, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007. The University/Institute will maintain separate audited accounts and would keep whole of the grant in a bank account earning interest, the interest earned should be reported to the DST. The interest thus earned will be treated as a credit to the Institute to be adjusted towards further installment of the grant.
