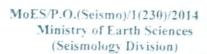

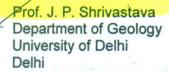

There is major gap in paleopedological understanding of the Himalayan Foreland Basin (HFB). paleopedological investigation of the fossil soils from Dagshai Formation provides an important insight about the oldest tropical weathering during Paleogene time (Srivastava et al., 2013; Srivastava and Sauer, 2014).
