



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

his Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been executed at Delhi on the 10th day of September 2015.

#### Between:

Tata Power Delhi Distribution Limited a company incorporated under the Companies Act 1956 having its registered office at NDPL House, Hudson Lines, Kingsway Camp, Delhi 110 009 (hereinafter referred to as TPDDL which expression shall unless repugnant to the context in which used mean and include its successors in interest and permitted assigns) of the First Part;

#### And

Delhi School of Social Work Society (DSSWS), a society registered under societies registration Act 1860 having its office at 3, Delhi University Road, University of Delhi, New Delhi 110007, (hereinafter referred to as Society which expression shall unless repugnant to the context in which used mean and include its successors in interest and permitted assigns) of the Other Part;

Whereas TPDDL is an electricity distribution licensee engaged in supplying electricity to its consumers in North and North West areas of NCT of Delhi.

Whereas Society is established with the objective of "To promote education, research, training and action in the field of social welfare and development".

#### Whereas

It is mutually agreed that TPDDL and Delhi school of Social Work society are signing this MoU to outline the Principles of Association (PoA) that will provide guidelines for conducting survey to identify Socio Economic Study of JJ cluster inhabitants for linkages with TPDDL-CSR and other activities from the month of October 2015.

- a) Whereas TPDDL and Society have in association with each other to establish baseline socioeconomic conditions in six identified JJ cluster falling in TPDDL area of operations for JJ clusters Residents and the region in general, including their livelihood measures and purchasing power.
- b) And whereas parties desire to have their association further subject to following terms and conditions:

## In witness whereof this MoU witnesseth a follows:

- 1. <u>Term:</u> The term of this MoU shall be a period of 3 months commencing from October 2015 to December 2015 subject however to earlier termination or extension.
- 2. Governing law and jurisdiction: This MoU shall be governed by applicable laws in force in India and any matter arising here from shall be subject to jurisdiction of the competent courts at Delhi.

- 3. Dispute Resolution & Arbitration: In case of any dispute or difference having arisen between the parties the same shall be sought to be resolved within a period of 7 days through mutual conciliatory measures to be initiated by the senior officers of both the parties failing which the matter shall be referred to arbitration. The arbitration shall be conducted by the sole arbitrator who shall be the Managing Director of TPDDL or his nominee. Society shall have no objection as against the same. The arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 and the seat of arbitration shall be Delhi. The language to be used at such proceedings shall be English and the award of arbitrator shall be final and binding on parties .The parties shall bear their respective costs of arbitration.
- 4. Modification: In case the parties may intend to modify the terms of this MoU the same may be effected through mutual MoU duly recorded in writing and signed by authorized signatories of both the parties.
- 5. Notice: Any notice or other correspondence required to be exchanged by and between the parties shall be addressed as follows and sent through personal delivery , registered post , speed post, recognized courier service, fax or email:

- 6. Roles and Responsibilities: The respective roles and responsibilities of the parties is as per the Schedules enclosed herewith which shall form part of this MoU and shall be read accordingly.
- 7. Location of Survey: For the purpose of this MoU the terms beneficiary shall mean refer to and include people residing in JJ clusters of - (i) Katputli colony, (ii) Dera Gazi Khan, (ii) EE Block, Jahangir Puri, (iii) CD Block, Jahangir Puri (iv) (v) C-Block, Near Eidgah, Jahangir Puri (vi) CD Park-II (Subzi Mandi) belong to poorest of poor /BPL card Holder category.
- 8. Relation between parties: The parties will act on principal to principal basis and there shall be no other relation between the parties whether that of agency, partnership, employer employee or any other. Neither party's acts nor omission shall be binding on the other party. Total population covered 20% of the identified population that will be around 850 families in all.

9. Role of Society:

Society will arrange to deploy and appoint at its own cost and expense suitable educated persons/MSW/BSW Volunteers to facilitate for data collection in JJ clusters. At no point of time such persons shall be deemed to be employees of TPDDL.



- It shall be responsibility of Society to appoint dedicated field coordinators to get the questionnaire filled by JJ Clusters consumers properly and submitted to concerned person for further perusal.
- iii. Field coordinators will visit the community regularly and should be in touch with TPDDL to give comprehensive report.
- iv. Society shall submit Survey report including detail analysis of survey along with payment invoice to TPDDL. Society officials shall interact with TPDDL for the feedback if any.
- 10. <u>Payment</u>: Overall, TPDDL shall make total payment of Rs. 6, 40,750 /- (Rupees six lakh forty thousand seven hundred fifty only) for the Project. This project is for 3 months which will cover 6 clusters consisted of approximately 4264 families in which 20% of the identified population that is 850 families in all would be covered in this survey

The 30 % of total payment will be given to society in advance after signing MoU, before conducting survey for preliminary expenses i.e., Rs. 1, 92,225 and rest of the 70% of amount will be paid to the society after getting comprehensive report of survey i.e., Rs. 4, 48,525.

- 11. The parties will share the feedback on the report/Data taken and take appropriate steps for corrective / betterment measures as may be required.
- 12. The prices are fixed during the MoU period and shall not be subject to escalation on any account whatsoever.


