One Belt One Road- Is it a Chinese Grand Strategy?

A country's grand strategy can be defined as the broadest approach to the pursuit of its national objectives in the international system (Dorff 2001). So the first step in analyzing a state's grand strategy is to discern its national objectives. The next step involves understanding the international system within which a state seeks to pursue its national objectives. A grand strategy exists within international politics but does not coincide with its boundaries (Luttwak 2001).

Major contributions in this field are made by Wang Jisi, Yan Shue Tong and Mickel Swaine.

I have not made any original contributions in the proposed field of study.

Research Question: One Belt One Road- Is it a Chinese Grand Strategy?

Hypotheses: One Belt One Road is an integral part of Chinese 21st century Foreign Policy Strategy

Research Methodology:

The research methodology I will be using here is a qualitative one. The conceptual framework will be derived from studies of world order, geo-economics and geo-politics. Primary sources including government documents, archives, reports and records will be consulted.

Secondary literature and official reports on OBOR will be used. Internet sources will also be consulted for this purpose.

Thus China's grand strategic paradigm may be discerned by answering the following six questions:

1. What is China's perception of itself and what role it aspires to play in the international system?
2. What are China's national objectives?
3. What is the international system within which China pursues these objectives?
4. What are the available grand strategic means?
5. What grand strategic ends does China seek?
6. Will OBOR change the way world looks at China?
