Subject: Implementation of Indo-Russian Joint project entitled: "Quaternary paleoclimate and paleoecology via multiproxy analysis of paleosol sequences across the Russian Plain and Himalaya" Coordinated by Prof. Pankaj Srivastava, University of Delhi, Delhi - regarding.

Sanction of the President is hereby accorded for incurring an expenditure not exceeding Rs. 25,41,164/- (Rupees Twenty Five Lakh Forty One Thousand One Hundred Sixty Four Only) for implementation of the Indo-Russian joint project entitled "Quaternary paleoclimate and paleoecology via multiproxy analysis of paleosol sequences across the Russian Plain and Himalaya" Coordinated Prof. Pankaj Srivastava, University of Delhi, Delhi with the Russian partner Dr. Alekseev Andrey, Federal Scientific Center, Pushchino Center of Biological Research Russian Academy of Sciences Moscow region, Russia for a total duration of Two years from the date of issue of the Sanction Order.
