Sanction of Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB) is hereby accorded to the above mentioned project of total cost of **Rs. 2074660/-** (Rs. Twenty Lakh Seventy Four Thousand Six Hundred and Sixty Only) with break-up of **Rs. 92900/-** under Capital (Non-recurring) head and **Rs. 1981760/-** under General (Recurring) head for a duration of 12 months. 2. Sanction of the SERB is also accorded to the payment of Rs. 92900/- (Rupees Ninety Two Thousand Nine Hundred only) under 'Grants for creation of capital assets' and Rs. 660600/- (Rupees Six Lakh Sixty Thousand Six Hundred only) under 'Grants-in-aid General' to Registrar, University Of Delhi, New Delhi, Delhi being the first installment of the grant for the year 2020-2021 for implementation of the said research project.

3. The expenditure involved is debitable to Fund for Science & Engineering Research (FSER) This release is being made under Empowerment and Equity Opportunities for Excellence in Science. (Task force Committee) (SC)

4. The Sanction has been issued to University Of Delhi, New Delhi, Delhi with the approval of the competent authority under delegated powers on 11 December, 2020 and vide Diary No. SERB/F/5545/2020-2021 dated 11 December, 2020.

5. Sanction of the grant is subject to the conditions as detailed in Terms & Conditions available at website ([www.serb.gov.in](http://www.serb.gov.in)).

6. Overhead expenses are meant for the host Institute towards the cost for providing infrastructural facilities and general administrative support etc. including benefits to the staff employed in the project.

7. While providing operational flexibility among various subheads under head Recurring-II, it should be ensured that not more than Rs. 1.5 lakh each should be spent for travel and contingency.

8. Budget sanctioned under Scientific Social Responsibility (SSR) is meant only for activities enlisted under SSR norms and under no circumstances it can be reappropriated.

9. As per rule 211 of GFR, the accounts of project shall be open to inspection by sanctioning authority/audit whenever the institute is called upon to do so.

10. The sanctioned equipment would be procured as per GFR and its disposal of the same would be done with prior approval of SERB.

11. The release amount of Rs. 753500/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Fifty Three Thousand Five Hundred only) will be drawn by the Under Secretary of the SERB and will be disbursed by means of RTGS transaction as per their Bank details given

The project File no. EEQ/2020/000238 may also be mentioned in all research communications arising from the above project with due acknowledgement of SERB.


