2. 5. The objectives of the study are as under:

The broad objectives of the study are to examine the implementation of Chapter III of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 in the NCT of Delhi and examination of the Performance of the Duties and Responsibilities of the Police Officers, Protection Officers and other Service Providers appointed under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 in the NCT of Delhi.

- i. To examine the implementation of chapter III of the Domestic Violence Act in the state of NCT of Delhi, that is, examine the role, responsibility and duties of the officers appointed under the law. whether facilities like free counselling, medical examination, free legal aid, shelter homes are readily available to the victims or not? To suggest efficient means of implementation if needed.
- ii. To check the coordination of various service providers under the Act necessary to ensure speedy remedies to aggrieved women.
- iii. To check if any protocols are prepared and put in place by the government for delivery of services under this Act as per section 11 of the Act.

6. The grantee organization would conduct the study in the State and locations as under:

Proposed study areas and sample size	The study shall be conducted in Delhi. All the protection officers, service providers i.e., Shelter homes, NGOs providing counselling facilities and medical facilities in the NCT of Delhi will be covered. The assigned police officers and magistrates will be also be covered for the study. On the basis of reported cases and by random sampling, victims of domestic violence will be covered.

7. The study Project shall be completed within a period of 12 months from the date of receipt of funds from Ministry. In case project period extension is inevitable that would be done only with prior approval of the Ministry. After utilization of the first instalment of grant, the grantee organization is required to submit audited statement of expenditure and Utilization Certificate against the first instalment of grant to enable release of subsequent or second instalment of grant for this project. However, before release of 2nd instalment of grant for this study, the Organization would be required to give a presentation in the Ministry (to the subject Bureau) for satisfactoriness of the study progress and quality of work etc.

8. The Accounts of the grantee shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act. 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Account Office of the Ministry, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so. The grant-in-aid extended hereby is subject to the terms and conditions laid down in the grant-in-aid rules,

9. The grantee organization shall implement the EAT (Expenditure Advance Transfer) module at all level in the PFMS Portal (Public Financial Management System) and also enter the upload GIA Expenditure incurred, Unspent Balance and Utilization Certificate in the PFMS Portal besides sending it in physical form to this Division. The subsequent final instalment will be released only after confirmation of the acceptance of the UC by the Division and entering previous Utilization Certificate in the PFMS.
