**ORDER**

Subject: Financial Sanction of the research project titled "Spectroscopic Characterization of Curcumin-Polymer Nano-Complexes" under the guidance of Prof. Subho Mozumdar, Chemistry, University of Delhi, Department of Chemistry, University of Delhi, Delhi - 7, New Delhi, Delhi-110007 - Release of 1st grant.

Sanction of Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB) is hereby accorded to the above mentioned project at a total cost of Rs. 4219600/- (Rs. Forty Two Lakh Nineteen Thousand Six Hundred Only) with break-up of Rs. 2000000/- under Capital (Non-recurring) head and Rs. 2219600/- under General (Recurring) head for a duration of 36 months. The items of expenditure for which the total allocation of Rs. 4219600/- has been approved are given below:

2. Sanction of the SERB is also accorded to the payment of Rs. 2000000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakh only) under 'Grants for creation of capital assets' and Rs. 739900/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Thirty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred only) under 'Grants-in-aid General' to The Registrar, University of Delhi, University of Delhi, Department of Chemistry, University of Delhi, Delhi - 7, being the first installment of the grant for the year 2018-2019 for implementation of the said research project.

3. The expenditure involved is debitable to Fund for Science & Engineering Research (FSER). This release is being made under Core Research Grant. (PAC Inorganic Physical Chemistry)

4. The Sanction has been issued to University Of Delhi, Department Of Chemistry, University Of Delhi, Delhi - 7 with the approval of the competent authority under delegated powers on 22 October, 2018 and vide Diary No SERB/F/8392/2018-2019 dated 22 October, 2018.

5. Sanction of the grant is subject to the conditions as detailed in Terms & Conditions available at website ([www.serb.gov.in](http://www.serb.gov.in))

6. Overhead expenses are meant for the host Institute towards the cost for providing infrastructural facilities and general administrative support etc. including benefits to the staff employed in the project.

7. While providing operational flexibility among various subheads under head Recurring II, it should be ensured that not more than Rs. 15 lakh each should be spent for travel and contingency.

8. As per rule 211 of GFR, the accounts of project shall be open to inspection by sanctioning authority/audit whenever the institute is called upon to do so.

9. The sanctioned equipment would be procured as per GFR and its disposal of the same would be done with prior approval of SERB.

10. The release amount of Rs. 2739900/- (Rupees Twenty Seven Lakh Thirty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred only) will be drawn by the Under Secretary of the SERB and will be disbursed by means of RTGS transaction as per their Bank details given below:

The institute will furnish to the CSIR, New Delhi, separate (Quarterly/semi-annual) financial year wise to CSIR for Recurring Expenditure (as and when) & Non-Recurring Expenditure for creation of capital assets and an audited statement of accounts pertaining to the grant immediately after the expiry of each financial year.

The institute will maintain separate audited accounts for the project. A part or whole of the grant may be put in an interest bearing bank account which is to be opened in CSIR. The interest free amount will be paid as credit to the institute to be adjusted towards further requirements of the grant.

The project file no. ESRG/2006/000009 may also be forwarded to all relevant committees above along with the above project with due acknowledgement of CSIR.

The manpower conditioned in the project if any is to remain with the duration of the project and CSIR will have no liability to meet the fellowship and salary of supporting staff & any beyond the duration of the project.

As this is the first grant being released for the project, no previous DDC is required.

The institute may refund any unspent balance to CSIR by means of a Demand Draft favouring FUND FOR SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING RESEARCH or payable at New Delhi.

The organization/institute/university should ensure that the technical support/financial assistance provided to them by the Science & Engineering Research Board, a statutory body of the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India should be highlighted/acknowledged in their media releases as well as in bold letters in the opening paragraphs of their annual Report.
