And

Delhi School of Economics (DSE), University of Delhi, having its office at Department of Sociology, Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi, Delhi- 110007 of the Other Part;

Whereas Tata Power DDL is an electricity distribution licensee engaged in supplying electricity to its consumers in North and North West areas of NCT of Delhi.

Whereas,

The Delhi School of Economics is much more than an institution for minting degrees and launching careers. It is a place where minds are shaped, lifelong friendships are formed and ideas are born and tested. It is a social and intellectual hub of one of India's leading public universities. In the campus we have the Ratan Tata library, considered to be housing the best collection in Sociology, economics in the country, has over 1,80,000 books, subscribes to nearly 1,25,000 bound periodicals and collects numerous publications of governments and international agencies.

It is mutually agreed that Tata Power- Delhi Distribution Limited and Department of Sociology, Delhi School of Economics are signing this MoU to outline the Principles of Association (PoA) that will provide guidelines for conducting **Impact Assessment of Tata Power- DDL CSR Initiatives**.

a) Whereas Tata Power DDL and Department of Sociology, Delhi School of Economics have in association with each other to assess impact of CSR initiatives falling in Tata Power DDL area of operations for JJ clusters Residents and the region in general

It is proposed that research work will be conducted in 12 districts of Tata Power- DDL in North and North- West part of Delhi, wherein the existing CSR initiatives are running at different Centres areas by 6 research assistants (1 research assistant would be responsible for 2 districts).

Following are the initiatives for which Tata Power- DDL would like Dr. Vikramendra Kumar, Assistant Professor Department of Sociology, Delhi School of Economics, Delhi University to conduct Impact Assessment.

1. Women Literacy Program.
2. ABHA Program.
3. Vocational Training Program
4. Tutorial program
5. KO Plant
6. Mobile Dispensary
7. Affirmative Action Program

The methodology used for data collection would be ethnographic research participant observation with both qualitative and quantitative comparison research design. The quantitative comparison research design will propose to collect data through purposive sampling and random stratified sampling. The survey would be conducted in 50 households of each initiatives across each 12 districts.

The total Household Respondent Participants would be approx. 4200 (60 for each initiative X 7 Initiatives). As the pandemic is ongoing, both virtual interaction and physical visits would be done to interact with the community beneficiaries, so as to complete the process on time.

b) The purpose of this study is to provide recommendations for further development based on the data gathered and to help Tata Power DDL to determine the areas where objectives have been achieved and that require improvements. This study will be helpful in upraising the strategies adopted in the implementation of CSR programs, assess the performance and report the impact.

TATA POWER-DDL

In witness whereof this MoU witnesseth a follows:

1. **Term:** The term of this MoU shall be a period of 15 month commencing from 8th February, 2022 subject however to earlier termination or extension.
2. **Governing law and jurisdiction:** This MoU shall be governed by applicable laws in force in India and any matter arising here from shall be subject to jurisdiction of the competent courts at Delhi.
- * 3. **Dispute Resolution & Arbitration:** In case of any dispute or difference having arisen between the parties the same shall be sought to be resolved within a period of 7 days
4. through mutual conciliatory measures to be initiated by the senior officers of both the parties failing which the matter shall be referred to arbitration. The arbitration shall be conducted by the sole arbitrator who shall be the Managing Director of Tata Power-Delhi Distribution Limited or his nominee. Society shall have no objection as against the same. The arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 and the seat of arbitration shall be Delhi. The language to be used at such proceedings shall be English and the award of arbitrator shall be final and binding on parties. The parties shall bear their respective costs of arbitration.
5. **Modification:** In case the parties may intend to modify the terms of this MoU the same may be effected through mutual MoU duly recorded in writing and signed by authorized signatories of both the parties.
6. **Notice:** Any notice or other correspondence required to be exchanged by and between the parties shall be addressed as follows and sent through personal delivery, registered post, speed post, recognized courier service, fax or email:

- 12. Research Assistants:** Department of Sociology, Delhi School of Economics will arrange to hire and appoint Post Graduate candidates experts in the field of social science research to facilitate data collection in JJ clusters. At no point of time such persons shall be deemed to be employees of Tata Power- DDL. It shall be responsibility of department of Sociology, Delhi School of Economics to appoint dedicated research assistants to gather authentic data from CSI beneficiaries and submit the same to Project Principal Investigator and Tata Power DDL for further perusal. Research Assistants will visit the community regularly and should update the Project Principal Investigator and Tata Power- DDL authorities so as to submit a comprehensive report.
- 13. Timeline:** This project is for one month. DSE, Department of Sociology shall be responsible for providing first draft of report to Tata Power DDL by end of March and can present the finalized report in second week of April.
- 14. Location:** This assessment will be covering 12 Districts for WLC, ABHAs, VT Program, Tutorial Program and for interaction with AA Graduate Beneficiaries, they would visit various ITIs and to assess the impact of Roshni (Soft Skill Training Development Program for girl students), the team would have to visit schools across districts. The location will be.
- 15. Payment:** Overall, Tata Power-DDL shall make total payment of **Rs.5, 04,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Four Thousands only)** for the Project. The payment will be paid to Dr. Vikramendra Kumar, Assistant Professor Department of Sociology, Delhi of Economics, University of Delhi, Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi as per following:


