Sanction of Science & Engineering Research Board (SERB), is hereby accorded to the above mentioned grant of Women Excellence Award to Dr. Priya Panjabi – Massand, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110 007 at the total sum of Rs. 18,00,000/- (Rupees Eighteen lakhs only) for a period of three years as given below:-

Sanction of the Science & Engineering Research Board (SERB), is also accorded to the payment of a sum of Rs. 6,00,000/- (Rupees Six lakhs only) as the 1st instalment of the grant under 'Grants in aid General' to The Registrar, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110 007 being the grant for the year 2014-15 for said award.

3. The expenditure involved is debitable to Fund for Science & Engineering Research for the year 2014-15 (Plan Expenditure- under recurring head)  
This release is made under the program "SERB Women Excellence Award"


4. The Sanction has been issued with the approval of the competent authority under delegated powers and vide Diary No.SERB/F/638/2014-15 dated: 30/04/2014.

6. The amount of Rs. 6,00,000/- (Rupees Six lakhs only) in question under 'Grants-in-aid General' will be drawn by the Drawing & Disbursing Officer of the SERB and will be disbursed by means of DD favouring "The Registrar, University of Delhi, Delhi" and will be sent to The Registrar, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110 007 or by means of RTGS transaction as per their Bank details given bellow:

7. As per rule 211 of GFRs, the accounts of Grantee Institution shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority/audit whenever the institute is called upon to do so.
8. The institute will furnish to the SERB, Utilization certificate and an audited statement of accounts etc, pertaining to the grant, immediately after the end of each financial year. A brief consolidated progress report may be sent at the end of each financial year and also on completion of the tenure, along with financial documents. The unspent balance if any after the tenure of the grant should be returned to SERB by means of a Demand Draft favouring, 'FUND FOR SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING RESEARCH', payable at New Delhi.
9. Overhead expenses are meant for the host Institute towards the cost for providing infrastructural facilities and general administrative support etc. including benefits to the staff employed in the project
10. The manpower sanctioned in the project, if any is co-terminus with the duration of the project and SERB will have no liability to meet the fellowship etc. beyond the duration of the project.
11. The institute will maintain separate audited accounts for the project. If it is found expedient to keep a part or whole of the grant in a bank account earning interest, the interest earned should be reported to the SERB, New Delhi. The interest thus earned will be treated as a credit to the institute to be adjusted towards further installment of the grant
12. As this is the first grant being released for the project, no previous U/C is required
